

REGULATION gifts received OFFICIALS

("Official Gazette", number 141/04)

Article first

This Regulation establishes the manner of gifts they receive officials in the exercise of public duties.

Article 2nd

An official may not receive money, regardless of the amount, other security or precious metal.

Article 3rd

An official may keep only gifts of symbolic value, mostly to the value of 500.00 kuna from the same donor.

The gift of a value above the amount referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article official may not keep.

Article 4th

The gifts from Article 3, paragraph 2 of this Regulation is given for the body in which he is the official, at the latest within eight days from receipt of the gift and the gift becomes the property of the Croatian.

About handover of the gift official certificate is issued.

Article 5th

The body in which the official serves as keep records of received gifts, which are handed over for use.

Records of gifts received contain the following information:

- the name and address of the official who received the gift and duty which he held at the time of receipt of the gift,
- name, last name and address of the donor, or the name and seat of the state body or legal person if the gift committed in the name of the state body or legal person or,
- a description of the gift,
- the date of donation,
- the date of the gift of the body in which the official performs duties.

Article 6th

The gifts that become the property of the Croatian, the regulations relating to the management and disposal of state assets.

Article seventh

This Regulation shall enter into force on the eighth day of its publication in the "Official Gazette".
